**Day 2:** Practical works how to build a bee hive (Cont.)

**Day 3:** Practical work, how to find and transfer of wild colonies to beehives  
(All participants need to work with bee-hiving)

- Theoretical Training: 22<sup>nd</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup>, January 2011
- Beekeeping practical training: 24<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> January 2011

**Place:** - Department of Agriculture of Pursat Province
